How can this visit enhance my child's learning?

This visit will enhance our History Topic. Children will learn what life was like for a child during WW2 including evacuation, rationing, wearing a gas mask and identity card. They will take a walk around the site looking at the iconic aircraft from WW2 and listen to talks about: The History of Elvington, Bomber Command, The Halifax and Weaponry of WW2

Children will also take part in The Paratrooper Experience: What it was like to be a Paratrooper on 6th June 1944 preparing to land in Normandy?

The pupils will be taken through the routine of checks immediately prior to their drop. This includes sound effects. (The sound is turned up loud and the guide does provide advance warning of this). The visit encompasses a whole host of other subjects and themes, from art, religious education and citizenship, to geography, design and science.

How can this visit enhance my child's learning?
